It encourages children to look at their heritage in the places they live, and through the medium of photography, develop an understanding of the things around them. It forms part of the International Heritage Photographic Experience, supported by the Council of Europe as part of Our Common Heritage initiative. *All* entries into PhotoArch are displayed online. Judges select two images to be passed to the IHPE organisers for publication.
