



# PhotoArch 2009

## Rules of Entry

The closing date for the 2008 competition is Friday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2009.

### Entrants

1. Each pupil may only submit one photograph.
2. Pupils must attend primary school or be of primary-school age (aged 4-11).
3. Family members of the judging panel may not take part in the competition.

### Images

4. Images must depict an element of Scotland's buildings, monuments or archaeology.
5. Images can be colour or black and white.
6. All images entered must be the original work of the entrant. If the image has been manipulated (cropped, for example), then this must have been done by the child.
7. If photographs contain images of children under the age of 18, a parent or guardian must have provided written permission for the photographs to be taken. Participating schools are responsible for ensuring this has been done.

### Submitting entries

8. A digital copy of each photograph must be submitted on CD-rom (feel free to put all the images from your school onto one CD). The Scottish Civic Trust cannot return these so retain a copy for your own records.

### Judging

11. Judges appointed by the Scottish Civic Trust and Historic Scotland will choose the winning entries. The judges' decision will be final.

### Copyright

12. Copyright of the images will remain with the entrant, though the Scottish Civic Trust will be granted non-exclusive rights in perpetuity for publication, digitisation, exhibition and broadcast. This may include the granting of reproduction rights to selected third parties for promotional or other uses, such as the International Heritage Photographic Experience.

### Conditions

13. All images are submitted at the entrant's own risk: the Scottish Civic Trust regrets that they cannot take any liability for loss of or damage to them. We regret that we cannot acknowledge receipt.
14. Entry to the competition confirms acceptance of the above rules.
